

DSWD DROMIC Report #11 on the Effects of LPAs, Northeast Monsoon, and Shear Line as of 15 January 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 15 January 2023 at 4:00 PM, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at 175 km East Northeast of Hinatuan, Surigao del Sur or 245 km East of Butuan City, Agusan del Norte (9.2°N, 127.2°E). Northeast Monsoon affecting Extreme Northern Luzon.

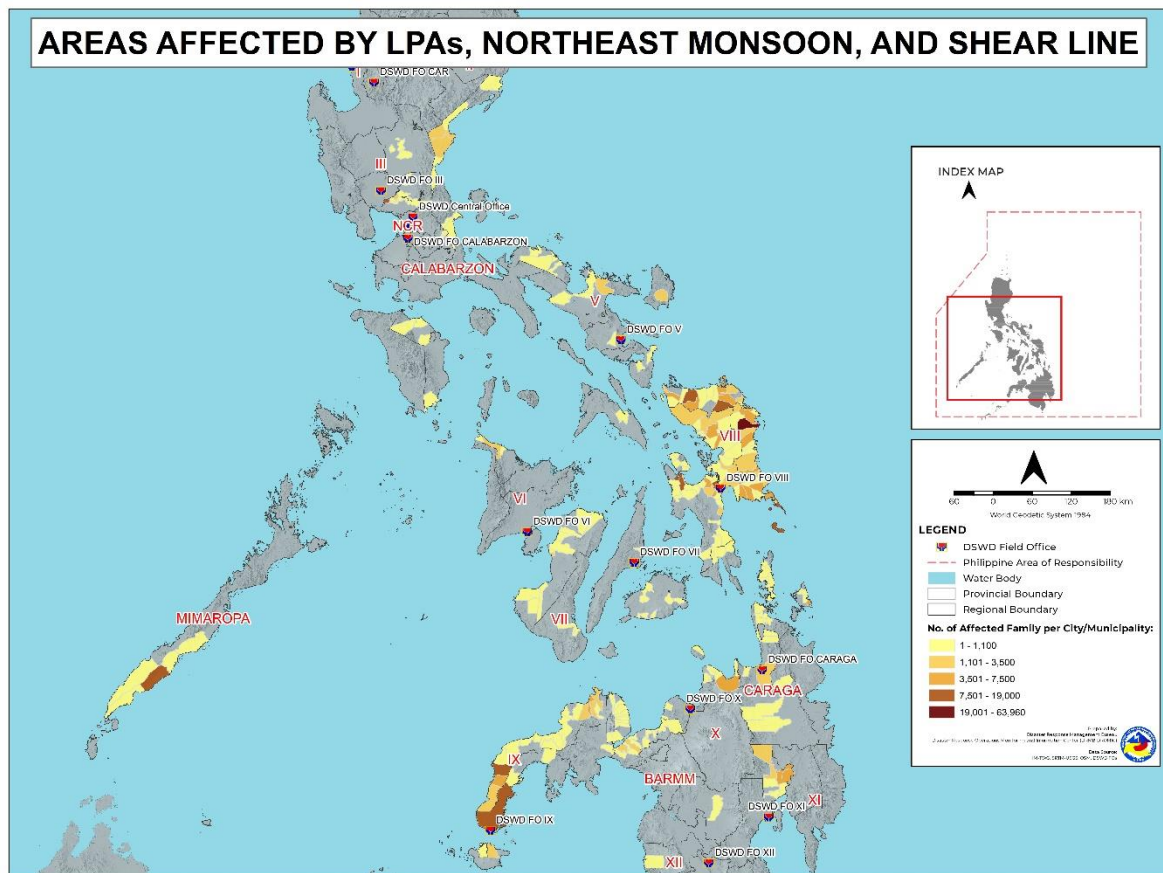
