

## DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Effects of the Trough of Low Pressure Area as of 28 October 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

Issued on 10 October 2023 at 4AM, the trough of Low Pressure Area (LPA) affected Visayas and Mindanao. On the same day, the effects of the trough of LPA were reported in the Municipalities of San Enrique and Barotac Viejo in Iloilo, and Cauayan in Negros Occidental. Flooding was also experienced in several barangays in the Municipality of Bansalan in Davao del Sur.

A total of **2,583 families** or **10,247 persons** are affected in **30 barangays** in **Regions VI and XI** (see Table 1).

A total of **63 families** or **295 persons** sought temporary shelter in **three (3) evacuation centers** in **San Enrique, Iloilo** (see Table 2).
