CARAGA

OCD

- Issued Caraga RDRRMC Memorandum Circular No. 4 s 2024, dated January 30, 2024 re: Maintaining of Caraga RDRRMOC Blue Alert Status ICOW Trough of LPA Affecting Caraga
- Closely monitoring and in close coordination with the affected LGUs and the entire region for timely and up to date reporting;
- Continuous dissemination of weather advisories, warnings and bulletins from PAGASA, NDRRMC and MGB.

DSWD

- DSWD-FO through SWAD TLs on continuous coordination with LGUs for timely updates for the effects of Trough of LPA;
- DRMD QRT activated for monitoring and coordination; and
- Constant monitoring of weather updates issued by PAGASA.

- Prepositioning of food;

- Continuous coordination with the BDRRMCs;
- Issued Memorandum Order on Suspension of Work in both Local and National agencies and Classes in all levels.

Municipality of Trento, ADS

- Issued Executive Order declaring Suspension of Classes and Work in all levels;
- Issued weather advisories to MDRRMC and BDRRMCs;
- Dissemination of weather conditions updates through Messenger;
- Frequent monitoring and close coordination with BDRRMCs for timely updates;
- Coordinated with Brgy. Poblacion and conducted pre-emptive evacuation;
- Activated EOC;
- Responder and personnel are on standby alert;
- Coordinate with Citizen's Crime Watch (CSO) in the conduct of pre-emptive evacuation at Brgy. Manat.
