OVERVIEW	<p>On 06 February 2024, around 7:40 PM, a landslide incident occurred at Zone 1, Brgy. Masara, Maco, Davao de Oro precipitated by the effects of Shear Line and Trough of Low-Pressure Area.</p> <p>Maco MDRRM Office, Davao de Oro PDRRM Office, Phil.Army, Mawab MDRM Office, and Mabini MDRRM Office immediately conducted forced evacuation of the affected Brgy. Masara and 5 other nearby barangays namely Mainit, Tagbaros, Elizalde, Panibasan, all of Maco Municipality, Davao de Oro due to possible damming effect.</p> <p>Currently, P/MDRRMOs, BFP Maco Station, 25th IB-PA, DavNor 911 together with APEX Mining Rescue Team are conducting Search, Rescue, and Retrieval Operations in the incident site.</p>

# Progress Report No. 3 for the Landslide Incident in Maco, Davao de Oro (REGION XI)

## ACTIONS TAKEN

### Region 11

#### OCD XI

- Coordinated with PDRRMO and MDRRMO Maco;
- Established virtual EOC Coordination Meeting with MGB XI, De Oro PDR, Maco MDR and RDRRMC XI member-agencies re Masara Landslide Incident;
- Coordinated with Regional response units (NFEM, PAF, BFP, Davao CDR, Del Sur, Occidental) for possible augmentation as signified by PDRRMO;
- Raising of OCD-RDRRMC XI Alert Status to RED;
- Deployed one (1) OCD XI personnel as augmentation to local IMT to provide technical assistance;
- Presented updates before the President during his presidential briefing at Davao City;
- Preparation for an aerial survey with MGB-RO XI personnel.

#### BFP XI

Coordinated with DILG & LDRRMCs in the conduct of Rescue and Retrieval Operations;  
Intensified the observance of PLAN PAGHALASA in close coordination with BFP Fire Stations at Cities/Municipalities;  
Ensured availability of BFP-Assets and PPEs at all times.

#### MGB XI

- Provided copies of reports from the geohazard surveys conducted by MGB since 2008.

#### DOH DCHD

- Continuous coordination with the MDRRMO and LGU for any updates;
- Updates and linelist to follow

#### DSWD XI

- Coordinated with the local government unit for updates on the incident and possible augmentation of F/NFI to the affected families;
- Administer family access card in emergencies and disaster (FACED) in Maco, Davao de Oro
- Set up modular tents to provide shelter for the victims affected by the landslide in Maco, Davao de Oro
- Conducts CCCM on evacuation sites

- Coordinated with 11 MDRRMOs of the Municipalities of Davao de Oro and OCD 11;
- PDRRMO Operations Center prepositioned resources and personnel for augmentation;
- Deployed 13 SRR personnel at Masara, Maco, Davao de Oro;

- Attended the OCD-RDRRMC Virtual EOC;
- Deployed PDRRMO personnel drone team at Masara, Maco to do aerial assessment;
- Assisted the Provincial Governor during the Presidential Briefing at the Malacanan of the South, Panacan, Davao City; and
- Conducted continuous monitoring.
