OVERVIEW	In the early morning of 01 March 2024, a flooding incident transpired at Malita, Davao Occidental due to moderate to heavy rains brought by easterlies/localized thunderstorms. On 02 March 2024, aside from Barangay Poblacion of Malita, additional flooding incidents were also reported in Barangay Basiawan and Barangay Poblacion of Municipality of Sta Maria where families and individuals were evacuated to barangay gyms.

Region 11

OCD XI

- Conducted continuous coordination with PDRRMO Davao Occidental and other relevant agencies
- Conducted continuous dissemination of EAWMs

PDRRMO Davao Occidental

- -Conducted close monitoring and coordination with the 5 municipalities
- -Continued dissemination of weather advisories on social media (Facebook page and Viber) and updates from the MDRRMOs through two-way radio

MDRRMO Sta. Maria

- In close monitoring of area of responsibility for any untoward incidents occurred due to continuous light to moderate rains through Easterlies/Localized Thunderstorms.
- -Rescued families for evacuation and transported them to evacuation area.
- -Referred evacuated families to MSWDO
- -Reported the situation to the LCE and MDRRMC.
- -Closely coordinated with the Barangay Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (BDRRMC) for any untoward incidents.
- -Assessed and validated the affected families.
- -Render 24/7 duty and monitoring at the MDRRMO Operation Center.
- -Submit Situational Report to the concerned agencies.
- -Continuous monitoring the area of responsibility especially upland/lowland area.

MDRRMO Malita

- -Close monitoring with in AOR;
- -Pre-emptive and force evacuation of affected and other families living along the risk are conducted.
- -Continuous coordination of BDRRM;
- -Continuous dissemination of information to all residents, thru SMS and social media and two -way radio

PHO Davao Occidental

- Raising of Code White Alert, and activation of PHO EOC as precautionary measures for any eventualities.
