OVERVIEW	On 18 June 2024, at around 03:00 PM, a flash flood incident occurred in Kabacan, Cotabato Province caused by over flowing of water from creeks and irrigation canals due to continuous thunderstorms.

ACTIONS TAKEN

Region 12

LGU Kabacan

MDRRMO, MSWDO, MAO and Kabacan Quick Response Team conducted ocular inspection and assessment in the affected communities.

MDRRMO, MSWDO and MAO still monitoring the situation in the AOR

LGU Tulunan

- MDRRMO conducted water level monitoring of rivers and flood-prone areas.
- MDRRMO conducted continuous dissemination of alerts and advisories especially those that are high risk to flooding
- MDRRMO conducted constant monitoring of and information dissemination to the barangays situated in high risk flood-prone areas.
- BLGU Popoyon provided hot meals for the displaced families.
- MSWDO Tulunan provided modular tents for the displaced families from Purok 8, Barangay Popoyon
