OVERVIEW	On 18 to 27 June 2024, flooding incidents transpired in the provinces of Maguindanao del Sur and Lanao del Sur due to the continuous heavy rains and thunderstorms brought by the Southwest Monsoon, ITCZ and LPA.
	Weather Forecast on 26 June 2024, 5:00 AM - Synopsis: Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) affecting Mindanao Forecast: Caraga and Davao Region will have cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms due to Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ). The rest of Mindanao will have partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms due to ITCZ. Light to moderate winds from south to southeast with slight to moderate seas.
	Weather Forecast on 25 June 2024, 5:00 AM - Synopsis: Easterlies affecting Mindanao Forecast: Caraga will have cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms due to easterlies. The rest of Mindanao will have partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms due to Easterlies/Localized Thunderstorms. Light to moderate winds from southeast to east with slight to moderate seas.
