OVERVIEW	On 30 June 2024 at around 4:30 PM, moderate to heavy rains were experienced over Davao City and Digos City due to Easterlies. The said weather condition caused the occurrence of flooding incidents. As of July 2, 2024, all internally displaced persons (IDPs) at Brgy. Inawayan, Sta. Cruz, Davao del Sur have returned to their respective houses.

Region 11

OCD XI

- Monitored and coordinated with CDRRMOs for situation update.

Davao City DRRMC

- Monitored the AOR and disseminated EAWMs to all concerned BDRRMCs thru Social Media, Radio Communication and SMS;

- Conducted Pre-emptive Evacuation of affected families particularly living along river banks in coordination with concerned BDRRMCs; and

- Provided hotmeals and other needed assistance to the affected families in coordination with Davao CSWDO

DOH- HEMS

- Monitored the incident and coordinated with CDOHO for updates.

Digos City DRRMC

- Monitored the AOR and disseminated EAWMs thru Social Media, Radio Communications and SMS; and

- Conducted clearing operations in the flooded area/s.

MDRRMO Sta. Cruz, Davao del Sur

- Monitored the AOR;

- Conducted Search and Rescue Operation;
- Pre-positioned goods, rescue equipment and BDRRMC Responders;
- Activated BDRRMC Operations Center;

- Dispatched teams to monitor the following barangays: Bato, Matutungan, Tagabuli, Saliducon, Darong, Inawayan, Astorga, Zone 1,2,3,4;

- Conducted debris clearing of uprooted trees at Almendras Cebulan, Brgy. Astorga;

- Provided transportation of trapped families and individuals at Brgys. Inawayan and Darong due to flooding; and

- Conducted evacuation of affected families in coordination with PNP Sta. Cruz, 39IB, PA, MSWDO, and concerned BDRRMCs.

MDRRMO Malita, Davao Occidental

- Monitored the AOR;
- Coordinated with BDRRM; and

- Disseminated information and advisories to all residents, thru Social Media, Text Blast and Two-way radio.

CDRRMO Mati, Davao Oriental

- Informed the City Engineer's Office Motorpool re status of the road;
- Deployment of the debris clearing team to the incident area;
- Coordinated with BDRRM Lanca for updates; and
- Advised commuters to take extra caution when approaching the road.

DSWD XI DROMIC
