





# DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Flooding Incident in Malabon City

as of 04 July 2024, 6PM

#### I. Situation Overview

On 07 June 2024, the Malabon-Navotas Flood Gate was damaged which since then caused flooding in Malabon City. Although the flooding subsides minutes or hours after, the properties and livelihoods of the families living in the flooded areas are still affected.

In response, the DSWD through its Field Office in the National Capital Region (NCR) provided relief assistance to support the immediate needs of the affected families.

A total of 190 families or 713 persons are affected in Malabon City (see Annex A).

#### **Outside Evacuation Center**

There are **190 families** or **713 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

#### IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱346,290.00 worth of assistance was provided by DSWD to the affected families (see Annex C).
