Progress Report No. 2 on the Effects of Localized Thunderstorms, ITCZ, and LPA in the Province of Sultan Kudarat (Region XII)

OVERVIEW	<p>On 25-26 June 2024-02 July 2024, continuous heavy rainfalls were experienced in the Province of Sultan Kudarat brought by localized thunderstorms, ITCZ, and LPA. This resulted in flashflood incidents in Esperanza and Lambayong and the presence of tension cracks in Bagumbayan.</p> <p>Chronology:</p> <p>On June 25, 2024, 10:00 AM, the presence of tension cracks in Barangay Masiag, Bagumbayan, Sultan Kudarat due to continuous heavy rainfall brought about by localized Thunderstorms was reported. The said tension cracks caused damages to several houses and roads (graveled road) in the affected area.</p> <p>On June 26, 2024, 5:30 PM, a flashflood incident that happened in Esperanza, Sultan Kudarat when creeks overflowed due to continuous heavy rainfall brought about by the ITZC/LPA was reported. The said incident affected families in the said area.</p> <p>On June 26, 2024, 11:30 PM, a flashflood incident that happened in Lambayong, Sultan Kudarat when the Allah River overflowed due to continuous heavy rainfall brought about by the ITZC/LPA was reported. The said incident affected families in the said area.</p> <p>On 30 June 2024, around 09:00 PM, a landslide incident (rain-induced) due to heavy rainfall brought about by ITCZ occurred in Brgy. Kadi and Brgy. Bugso in Sen. Ninoy Aquino, Sultan Kudarat. The said incident affected families, houses and roads in the said Barangays.</p> <p>On 02 July 2024, at around 5:00 AM, a flooding incident occurred in, Barangay Lutayan Proper, Municipality of Lutayan, Sultan Kudarat due to continuous moderate to heavy rainfall brought about by ITCZ. The incident affected families in the said barangay.</p> <p>On 02 June 2024, around 11:00 PM, a landslide incident (rain-induced) due to heavy rainfall brought about by ITCZ occurred in Brgy. Chua in Bagumbayan, Sultan Kudarat. The said incident affected families, houses and roads in the said Barangays.</p>

ACTIONS TAKEN**

Region 12

OCD XII

Continuous monitoring and coordination with concerned LGUs.

PGU Sultan Kudarat

- Close coordination with the affected LGUs.
- Monitored the weather status through the Local DRRM Operation Centers and LDRRMOs GC.

DPWH XII

- Deployed personnel and equipment to clear debris in landslide affected road network in Esperanza and Bagumbayan Sultan Kudarat.

DSWD XII

DSWD FO XII coordinated with MSWDO Lambayong for validation and gathering of initial disaster data.

LGU Senator Ninoy Aquino

- MDRRMC SNA conducted damage assessment in the affected areas.
- LGU SNA transported affected families to a safe location (within the same barangay), where they are currently staying with their relatives.
- MDRRMO SNA closely coordinated with affected Barangays.
- MDRRMO SNA conducted information dissemination within area of responsibility.

LGU Lutayan

- MDRRM OPCEN provided advisory to all BDRRMCs in the Municipality that Easterlies/ Wind Convergence will affect the municipality and may bring moderate to heavy rains.
- MDRRM OPCEN advised all BDRRMCs to monitor installed water level gauges and and take necessary precautionary measures.
- MEO conducted declogging and clearing operations of affected culvert box situated in the mentioned barangay.
- DRRMC was advised to open the Barangay Gym for possible evacuation of the affected residents.

LGU Bagumbayan

- MDRRMO Response, Monitoring and Damage Assessment Team conducted inspection of damages in the affected areas.
- Deployed RDANA Team to affected areas.
- Continuous monitoring of AOR concerned by the MDRRMO with the Masiag and Chua Barangay Officials and BDRRM Committee.
- Assisted the MSWDO on the ongoing Profiling of the affected population.

LGU Esperanza

- MDRRMO conducted assessment and validation in the affected areas.
- Continuous monitoring of water levels in waterways in the affected areas.

LGU Lambayong

- MDRRRMO Lambayong conducted assessment and validation of areas affected by flashflood.
- Deployed RDANA Team to the affected areas
