OVERVIEW	<p>On 8 July 2024 heavy to intense rains caused by thunderstorms were experienced over some areas in Cebu and Negros Oriental. The said weather condition caused flooding incidents.</p> <p>Per Weather Forecast issued by DOST PAGASA on 8 July 2024, at 4:00 AM, the Easterlies are affecting the eastern sections of Luzon and Visayas. This weather pattern could potentially cause flash floods or landslides during severe thunderstorms in the affected areas.</p>

ACTIONS TAKEN**

Region 7

OCD VII

-Continuous monitoring and coordination with concerned DRRMOs affected by the incident.

LGU MABINAY

- Conducted recoreda at Barangay Luyang Spillway
- Water Level Monitoring
- Closely monitoring on AOR
- Ldrrm personnel and equipment on standby
- Activated BDRRMC
- Continuous Dissemination of Weather Advisories

DSWD FO VII

- Continuous monitoring of the incident.
- Coordinated with the Bindoy MAT and Bindoy MDRRMO to gather further information about the incident. The LGU was assured of augmentation support upon their request.

8 July 2024

- Field Office 7, DRMD is in close coordination with C/MATs, LDDRMOs, and LSWDOs to monitor the affected families in the Region.
- DSWD 7, through the 10 members of the Bindoy Municipal Action Team, assisted the LGU in profiling the IDPs affected by the Easterlies in Bindoy, Negros Oriental.
- The latest weather updates from PAGASA are continuously monitored by the DSWD Regional DROMIC Focal Person who ensures these updates are widely disseminated to Provincial, City, and Municipal Action Teams.

9 July 2024

- FO7's Regional Director Shalaine Marie S. Lucero assured the LGUs and the Governor of augmentation support upon their request.
- The DRMD is continuously coordinating with the LGUs through the LDDRMOs, and LSWDOs to monitor the affected families.
- DSWD 7's DROMIC Focal Person continuously monitors the latest weather updates from PAGASA, ensuring wide dissemination to Provincial, City, and Municipal Action Teams.

LGU MANDAUE CITY

City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (CDRRMO)

- Assisted in the conduct of evacuation;
- Provided 15 modular tents in Barangay Ibabao gym;
- Suctioned flood waters in Brgy Tipolo;
- Conducted water level monitoring in rivers and creeks;
- Conducted roving in flood-prone areas.

City Social Welfare Services (CSWS)

- Conducted profiling / enlisting of the Internally Displaced Persons(IDPs);
- 13 personnel deployed at Barangay Ibabao evacuation area;
- Provided hot meals to IDPs;
- Provided meals to IDPs.

City Health Office (CHO)

- 5 personnel deployed at Barangay Ibabao evacuation area;
- Provided medical consultations to the IDPs;
- Provided nutrition in emergency and water and health sanitation;
- Conducted entomological survey in Barangay Paknaan on dengue vectors

Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP)

- Conducted water level monitoring in rivers and creeks.

Traffic Enforcement Agency of Mandaue (TEAM)

- Managed the movement of traffic flow in flooded areas.

Barangay DRRM Committees (BDRRMCs)

- Barangay Emergency Response Teams conducted roving and recorida in respective area of responsibility;
- Barangay Health Workers and midwives provided medical assistance.

LGU MINGLANILLA, CEBU

- MDRRMC OpCen continuously monitors the situation for any updates.
- Authorities have cautioned the area.
- Damaged electrical wires have caused the power lines to be cut off.
- Relief assistance served to the families.
- LGU provides financial support to the victims.

MDRRMO Carmen, Cebu

- *Continuous monitoring of flooded areas and weather updates.
- *Deployment of responders to affected areas.
- *Coordination made between Bureau of Fire Protection, PNP, MSWDO, PCG Carmen Sub-Station, MDRRMO and Rescue 211 of Danao City, Cebu
- *CERT MDRRMO personnel/responders deployed at Lower Natimao-an River to assess the incident and secured the area.
- *Conducted Search and Rescue Operation
- *Continuously Monitoring of the on-going search and rescue operations.
