OVERVIEW	Cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms due to Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) was forecasted to affect Western Visayas. On 09 July 2024 at around 11:00 PM heavy rains in Pototan, Iloilo caused flooding in low-lying barangays of Cau-ayan and Malusog, reaching households and not yet subsiding as of reporting time.

## AFFECTED POPULATION

A total of 83 families or 369 persons were affected. Of which, 7 families or 24 persons were served inside 2 ECs and 76 families or 345 persons were served outside ECs:

## **ACTIONS TAKEN**

### **Region 6**

#### **OCD VI**

1. Close coordination with the affected LGUs re the incident.
2. Continuous monitoring of the AOR.

#### **DSWD VI**

1. DSWD Field Office VI distributes food and non-food items (FNFI) to the families affected by the Effects of Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) in Pototan, Iloilo.
2. The Disaster Response Operations Management, Information and Communication (DROMIC) Division of DSWD-DRMB is closely coordinating with DSWD FO VI for significant disaster response updates and assistance provided.
