OVERVIEW	Cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms due to Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) was forecasted to affect Western Visasyas. On 09 July 2024 at around 11:00 PM heavy rains in Pototan, Iloilo caused flooding in low-lying barangays of Cau-ayan and Malusog, reaching households and not yet subsiding as of reporting time.

### Region 6

#### **OCD VI**

- 1. Close coordination with the affected LGUs re the incident.
- 2, Continuous monitoring of the AOR.

#### **DSWD VI**

- 1. DSWD Field Office VI distributes food and non-food items (FNFIs) to the families affected by the Effects of Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) in Pototan, Iloilo.
- 2. The Disaster Response Operations Management, Information and Communication (DROMIC) Division of DSWD-DRMB is closely coordinating with DSWD FO VI for significant disaster response updates and assistance provided.

- -Heightened monitoring
- -SRR Team on standby
- -Coordinated with other LGUS
- -Assisted the evacuees
- -Issued advisories to barangays
