OVERVIEW	On 27 August 2024, at around 09:45 PM, DOST-PAGASA issued an Orange Rainfall Warning over Metro Manila and other parts of Luzon due to the Southwest Monsoon (Habagat). This causes flooding in some parts of Metro Manila.

# Initial Report for the Effects of Southwest Monsoon in Metro Manila (NCR)

## ACTIONS TAKEN

### NCR

#### DSWD NCR

- Coordinating with LGUs for their pre-emptive evacuation center.
- Valenzuela City has opened a pre-emptive evacuation center ready to accommodate potentially affected families.
- DRMD closely coordinates with LGUs to monitor their disaster response activities.
- DRMD maintains close coordination with MMDRRMC member agencies such as OCD NCR, MMDA, PCG for significant weather updates and related information concerning the Low-Pressure Areas (LPAs).
- All DRMD Quick Response Team (QRT) members and emergency equipment are on standby and ready for deployment.
- DSWD NCR Warehouse in Isla Cargo, Paranaque City ensures the availability of Food and Non-Food Items (FNIs) for resource augmentation to LGUs as needed.

#### OCD NCR

- Monitoring of the situation
- Close coordination with other agencies

#### DOST PAGASA

- Vigilant and ongoing weather monitoring
- Issued weather advisories

#### DENR MGB

- Issued Geohazard Threat Advisory for NCR in relation to the Heavy rainfall due to the Southwest Monsoon in Metro Manila
