Initial Report for the Flooding Incident in Mandaue, Cebu (REGION VII)

ACTIONS TAKEN

Region 7

Office of Civil Defense VII

- Coordinated with LGU Mandaue City re flooding incident

City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (CDRRMO)

- Conducted rescue operations and evacuation of affected population;
- Provided thermal blankets to the Internally Displaced Persons (IDPs);
- Deployed 1 Ambulance with medical team in the evacuation area;
- Deployed 1 Firetruck to provide water in the evacuation area;
- Deployed 2 floodlights in the evacuation area;
- Conducted water level monitoring in rivers and creeks;
- Conducted roving in flood-prone areas.

City Social Welfare Services Office (CSWSO)

- Conducted profiling / enlisting of the IDPs;
- Provided packed meals to the IDPs.

City Health Office (CHO)

- Activated and deployed the health emergency response team in the evacuation area;
- Provided medical consultations to the IDPs;
- Deployed 1 midwife in the evacuation area;
- Deployed 1 nurse in the evacuation area;
- Deployed 7 BHWs in the evacuation area;
- Provided nutrition in emergency, water and health sanitation.

Barangay Response Team

Barangay Umapad Emergency Response Team

- Assisted in the rescue operations and evacuation of affected residents;
- Monitored the water level in the flooded areas;
- Conducted roving and recorida in the area of responsibility.

Barangay Alang-alang Emergency Response Team

- Monitored the water level in the flooded areas;
- Conducted roving and recorida in the area of responsibility.

Barangay Tingub Emergency Response Team

- Monitored the water level in the flooded areas;
- Conducted roving and recorida in the area of responsibility.

Barangay Paknaan Emergency Response Team

- Monitored the water level in the flooded areas;
- Conducted roving and recorida in the area of responsibility.
