ACTIONS TAKEN

Region 5

OCD 5

- Continuous provision of warnings and advisories to the LGUs, RDRRMC Member Agencies, other stakeholders and the general public.
- Continuous monitoring of the situation within the area of responsibility for possible deployment of regional resources.

CDRRMO LEGAZPI

- Emergency Operations Center (EOC) on Code Alert ORANGE, partial activation;
- Disseminated safety precautions, weather bulletins, and other related information (e.g Heavy Rainfall Warnings) through the Legazpi City DRRMO's Facebook Page;
- Monitored Tandem Stations (Dita and San Francisco) and AWS for rainfall events;
- Recorded hourly rainfall volume;
- Continuous monitoring of updates from PAGASA through their website and other social media platforms;
- Monitoring of river bodies and gulley
- Coordinated with mayon barangays for the possible lahar;
- Monitored CCTV live feed for possible flooding and incidents; and
- Coordinated with Barangy 58 Buraguis , MGB, ALECO, TFKKK, PSO, LCPS, and CEO re: Landslide Incident in Brgy. Buraguis

MDRRMO TIWI

- Conducted Weather monitoring using 24-7 weather monitoring using the Automated Weather Station, PAGASA weather updates and all other available resources
- Conducted monitoring of landslide and flood prone barangays
- Dissemination of rain fall warnings to punong barangays

PDRRMO CAMARINES SUR

- Issued the following PDRRMC Memoranda:
 - o Weather Warning and Preparedness Advisory (November 28, 2024)
 - o Implementation of Pre-emptive Evacuation (December 1, 2024)
- Close monitoring and dissemination of the following advisories issued by DOST-PAGASA to PDRRMC, LDRRMCs, and the general public:
 - o Daily Weather Forecasts
 - o Bicol River Daily Hydrological Forecasts
 - o General Flood Advisories
 - o Rainfall Advisories
- Close coordination with PDRRMC members and C/MDRRMOs re situations in their respective area of responsibility (AOR).
- Deployed one (1) search and rescue (SAR) team to assist in ongoing SAR operations for reported two (2) missing persons in Cabusao.
- Resources and personnel on standby ready for deployment.

PDRRMO CATANDUANES

- Continuous monitoring and coordination with MDRRMOs to ensure timely submission of situational reports within their areas of responsibility (AOR).
- Continuous monitoring of Weather updates due to Shearline
- Coordination with line agencies (PAGASA, PNP, BFP, PCG, PSWDO) ongoing.

- Dissemination of weather updates social media;
- On going clearing operations.

MDRRMO MOBO

- Continuous monitoring of the situation.
- Activation of Barangay EOCs
- Emergency Operations Center Activation: Both the Municipal and Barangay Emergency Operations Centers were activated.
- Coordination and Information Dissemination: Continuous coordination and information sharing regarding the heavy rains /shear line status and updates were conducted through local radio, social media, and barangay announcements.
- Evacuation Center Preparation: The Evacuation Centers were prepared and coordinated by the MSWDO.
- Weather Monitoring: The MDRRMO personnel continuously monitored weather updates from PAGASA.
- Barangay Communication: Regular communication was maintained with barangay officials for localized updates and swift actions.
- Road Clearing and Declogging Operations: The MDRRMO, in collaboration with BDRRMCs, PCG Mobo and BFP Fire Mobo Station conducted clearing operations and declogging of canals and water ways.
- Assisted Evacuees:
- Conducted Rapid Damaged Assessment and Needs Analysis (RDANA)
- Decamping of Evacuation Centers: Evacuees stayed at EC for about 2hrs - 3 hrs only during the height of Heavy rains and flooding.
- Submission of Terminal Report to PDRRMO and OCD.
- Deactivation of EOC: The 24/7 Emergency Operations Center was deactivated.

PDRRMO SORSOGON

- Monitoring and coordination with Blue Lane Marshall and authorities for the status and management of traffic along Matnog Maharlika Highway;
- SPDRRMO issued Weather Advisory No. 1 for the SHEARLINE;
- Deployed Response Team to Brgy. Bucalbucalan and Rizal along Maharlika Highway;
- Ensure clear lines of communication with all C/MDRRMOs for updates and coordination;
- Operation Center (OpCen) on standby 24/7;
- Conducted Operational Briefing for SPDRRMO responders;
- Continuously observing the minimum health standard for Emerging and Re-emerging Infectious Diseases (ERIED)
