

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Flooding Incident in Brgy. San Jose, Navotas City

as of 02 July 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 28 June 2025 at around 10:30 AM, a flooding incident occurred at Celes St., Brgy. San Jose, Navotas City. The Local Government Unit (LGU) of Navotas City reported that the flooding incident was due to high tide and a collapsed wall.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **293 families** or **1,189 persons** are affected in **Brgy. San Jose, Navotas City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **79 families** or **325 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Navotas Elementary School 1** in **Brgy. San Jose, Navotas City** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **214 families** or **864 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are 293 families or 1,189 persons still displaced in Brgy. San Jose, Navotas City (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 117 houses were partially damaged in Brgy. San Jose, Navotas City (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P930,861.00** worth of assistance was provided by **other Partners** to the affected families (see Annex F).
