

# DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Flash Flood Incident in Brgy. Poblacion, Pangantucan, Bukidnon

as of 09 October 2025, 6AM

#### I. Situation Overview

Issued on 07 October 2025, cloudy skies with scattered rains and thunderstorms might have brought possible flash floods or landslides due to moderate to at times heavy rains in Visayas, Mindanao and Palawan due to Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ). On the same day, a flash flood incident was experienced in Brgy. Poblacion, Pangantucan, Bukidnon.

In response, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office X, is in close coordination with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Pangantucan, Bukidnon, for significant updates and any requests for relief augmentation.
