OVERVIEW	Based on DOST – PAGASA’s Localized 24-Hour Public Weather Forecast issued at 05:00 AM of 06 October 2025, Zamboanga Peninsula will have scattered rains and thunderstorms caused by Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) that may bring possible flash floods or landslides due to moderate to at times heavy rains. Several areas in Zamboanga Peninsula experienced flooding incidents due to the incessant rains brought by the Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ).

Region 9

OCD IX

- In close coordination with the affected LGUs and DSWD IX for additional details, disaster response updates, and issues that may need immediate action.

LGU Labason, Zamboanga del Norte

- Coordination with BDRRMC, -Conducted site inspection
- Continuous monitoring
- Provide precautions to the public

LGU Sirawai, Zamboanga del Norte

- Conducted rescue retrieval operations, road clearing and rapid assessment

LGU Isabela City

- Dissemination of advisories to all BDRRMC
- Continuous monitoring of PAGASA weather bulletin and other weather forecast websites
- Barangay Official of low-lying/flood prone areas are advised to be alert against possible hazards
- Mobilized all CIRENS member in different barangay to monitor their AOR
- Conducted damaged assessment in Brgy. Makini

LGU Jolo, Sulu

- Jolo MDRRMO together with Brgy. San Raymundo BDRRMO, Municipal Engineering Office and DPWH Sulu personnel immediately responded to the area and assess the situation and coordinate necessary actions
- Provided financial assistance to the victims to the victims and shouldered all their medical and hospital expenses
- Continuous coordination with Barangay San Raymundo officials is being maintained to identify and monitor other old or potentially hazardous trees in the area to prevent similar incidents in the future

DPWH IX

- Deployment of heavy equipment to the areas affected with landslide and soil erosion

DSWD IX

- DSWD Field Office IX in coordination with the MSWDO provided 29 Sleeping Kits and Family Kits to families inside evacuation center in Sirawai, Zamboanga del Norte.
- DSWD Field Office IX through its Disaster Response Management Division in coordination with PPA Zamboanga City provided Ready-to-Eat Food (RTEF) Packs to 25 Locally Stranded Individuals (LSIs) who opted to stay at the Port Terminal.
- The DRMD facilitated the turning over of 64 LSIs at Zamboanga City Port who voluntarily opted to sought refuge at the Processing Center for Displaced Persons (PCDP) at Mampang, Zamboanga City. Meals and accommodation were provided to said individuals inside the facility.
- DSWD Field Office IX is continuously coordinating with the MSWDO of Gualac for updates and requests for further relief assistance and augmentation needed by the affected families.

- DSWD Field Office IX in coordination with the MSWDO of Gutalac provided 29 Hygiene Kits to the affected families in Brgy. Matunoy.
- Timely monitoring of weather forecast from DOST-PAGASA and coordination with P/C/MDRRMOS and SWDOs for report updates.
- Continuous coordination with LGU Gutalac, ZDN and LGU Zamboanga City for additional relief assistance and augmentation needed by the affected families and individuals.
