

# DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Flash Flood Incident in Kabacan, North Cotabato

as of 19 October 2025, 6AM

#### I. Situation Overview

Issued on 17 October 2025 at 4:00 AM, cloudy skies with scattered rains and thunderstorms might have brought possible flash floods or landslides due to moderate to at times heavy rains in Mindanao due to Localized Thunderstorms. On the same day at around 3:30 PM, a flash flood incident was experienced in some barangays in Kabacan, North Cotabato.

In response, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office XII, is in close coordination with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Kabacan, North Cotabato, for significant updates and any requests for relief augmentation.
