

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Effects of Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) in SOCCSKSARGEN as of 23 October 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

Issued on 22 October 2025, at approximately 4:00 PM, cloudy skies with scattered rains and thunderstorms caused by Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) may have brought possible flash floods or landslides during moderate to at times heavy rains in SOCCSKSARGEN.

On the same day, at around 3:00 PM, a flash flood and flooding incident occurred in the municipalities of Tantaranan and City of Koronadal in South Cotabato, as well as in the municipality of Lutayan in Sultan Kudarat, resulting in the displacement of 1,293 families with a corresponding 5,784 individuals.

In response, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through Field Office XII, is closely coordinating with the concerned Local Government Units (LGUs) to monitor the situation, gather significant updates, and assess the immediate needs of the affected families. The Field Office also stands ready to provide relief augmentation and other forms of assistance as necessary.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **1,128 families** or **4,959 persons** are affected in **10 Barangays** in **SOCCSKSARGEN** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **31 families** or **104 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **two (2) evacuation centers** in **SOCCSKSARGEN** (see Annex B).
