# **Progress Report No. 2 for the Effects of Shear Line in Bicol Region (Region V)**

## **ACTIONS TAKEN**

### **Region 5**

#### **OCD 5**

- On-going coordination with LDRRMOs and NGAs for the effects of LPA and SW Monsoon
- Mobilities are on standby in case of deployment;
- Radio communications and SATELLITE PHONE on standby.
- Timely dissemination of Weather Forecasts, Rainfall Warnings, Rainfall Advisories, MGB Advisories and other weather-related issuances to the LGUs and the General Public.

#### **PDRRMC CAMARINES SUR**

- Close monitoring and dissemination of the following advisories issued by DOST- PAGASA to PDRRMC, LDRRMCs, and the general public: Daily Weather Forecasts  
Bicol River Daily Hydrological Forecasts  
General Flood Advisories  
Rainfall Advisories
- Close coordination with PDRRMC members and C/MDRRMOs re situations in their respective area of responsibility (AOR).

#### **PDRRMO CATANDUANES**

- Continuous monitoring of PAGASA weather bulletins.
- Ongoing observation of updates from line agencies.
- Consolidation of reports from various agencies and MDRRMOs.
- Coordination with MDRRMOs to ensure timely submission of situational reports within their areas of responsibility (AOR).
- Dissemination of Advisories.

#### **PDRRMO ALBAY**

- Continues monitoring with PAGASA for the latest weather update.
- Consolidate situational reports from LGUs on impacts of Shear line.

#### **PDRRMO Camarines Norte**

- Sending of warning /preparedness measure thru SMS Media (GC and Fb) to all barangay especially to high-risk barangay to monitor, prepare and conduct necessary action to their high-risk areas for flooding and landslide
- The DWLB as designated Early Warning System continuously informing the public re: reminders/preparedness measure due to possible effects of the Shearline
- Continues monitoring of weather disturbances, spillways, and flood prone areas
- Monitors the weather conditions

#### **PDRRMO Sorsogon**

- Continuous monitoring and dates on Weather & Bulusan Volcano and dissemination of information to SPDRRMC Member/C/MDRRMCOs, the public, and concerned persons through Broadcast, social media, INFOBOARD, and INFOSYS;
- Continuous monitoring and coordination with Blue Lane Marshall and authorities for the status and management of traffic along Matnog Maharlika Highway;
- BLUE Alert Status due to Bulusan Volcano being at Alert Level 1 with Low-level Unrest;

- All Disaster Response Assets and Resources are in standby;
- Ensure clear lines of communication with all C/MDRRMOs for updates and coordination;
- Operation Center on standby 24/7.
